The SC5 scanner scans linear bar codes that are up to 4.2" wide from near contact to about 10" away at 200 scans per second. In addition, the SC5 scanners can be exported for use by PrimeCare's overseas clients. Both linear (Code128) and two-dimensional (PDF417) bar codes are used within the *PrimeCare Patient Management System*.
